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Flash Pictures, Numbers, Names to 10

Ideas for Activities

Instructions are adaptable for teachers/parents/carers and activities can be used with 1 child, a small group or a class.

1. Lay out as an activity for 3 children to match each number to its correct quantity and number name. Each child could get one of each category of cards i.e. numbers, names, pictures.
2. Use as a flash card teaching tool for quick recognition of numbers and the pictorial pattern. (subitising) and the number names.
3. Use as a teaching tool with whole class or group and fix one set of number cards 0-10 at a time to white board or washing line and in turns ask children to come and match the corresponding pictorial cards and number names.
4. Use for ordering numbers to 10 or for ordering pictorial cards to 10 or for ordering number names to 10.
5. Use with whole class or group and together with children order either the number cards or the pictorial cards or the number names cards. Then play a game by removing one card as children close their eyes and then asking in turns what card has been removed.
6. Fix a number card or number name card to board and ask children in turns to come and draw a matching quantity of something simple such as circles.
7. Fix a pictorial card to board and ask children to come and write the number to match the quantity.
8. Place a selection of mixed number, pictorial and name cards into a bag or box and in turns ask children to come and take out one card and either say what number they see or count how many objects they see.

FLASH PICTURES, NUMBERS, NAMES TO 10

IDEAS FOR ACTIVITIES

1

Lay out as an activity for 3 children to match each number to its correct quantity and number name. Each child could get one of each category of cards i.e. numbers, names, pictures.

2

Use as a flash card teaching tool for quick recognition of numbers and the pictorial pattern. (subitising) and the number names.

3

Use as a teaching tool with whole class or group and fix one set of number cards 0-10 at a time to white board or washing line and in turns ask children to come and match the corresponding pictorial cards and number names.

4

Use for ordering numbers to 10 or for ordering pictorial cards to 10 or for ordering number names to 10.

5

Use with whole class or group and together with children order either the number cards or the pictorial cards or the number names cards. Then play a game by removing one card as children close their eyes and then asking in turns what card has been removed.

6

Fix a number card or number name card to board and ask children in turns to come and draw a matching quantity of something simple such as circles.

7

Fix a pictorial card to board and ask children to come and write the number to match the quantity.

8

Place a selection of mixed number, pictorial and name cards into a bag or box and in turns ask children to come and take out one card and either say what number they see or count how many objects they see.
